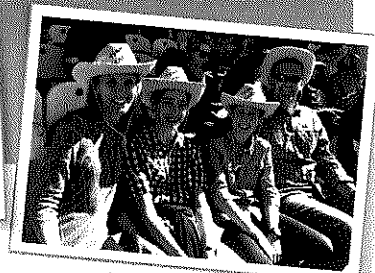

Unfortunately Casey just missed out on bringing a medal home - coming 4th in each of the four events she participated in - lots of training to do over the next four years till the next National Games...

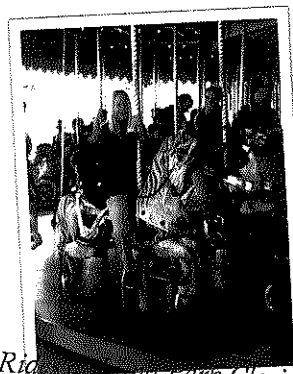

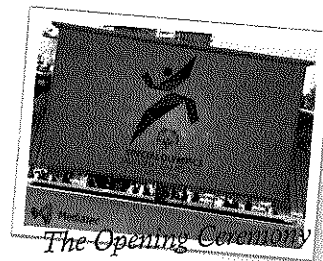
