

EA (formally EFA) Rule Exemptions

RDA has a form that any rider can use to apply for exemptions to EA rules due to a disability. This is most useful for riders who compete in open EA competitions and have not been classified for RDA, but have a medical condition that puts them at a disadvantage in able-bodied competition. Classified RDA riders do not need to use this form as any exemptions will have been recorded during classification. Please find the form attached.
