Following the November Meeting the RDAQ Board resolved to continue supporting RDAQ affiliated Centres by offering the following assistance for 2016:

- RDAQ will purchase the State 2016 insurance through AON This is in conjunction with both Western Australia and South Australia who have also decided to use AON as their insurance providers for 2016.
- o RDAQ will pay the AON Insurance package for those centres who indicate they wish to participate in the scheme by December 10th 2016.
- Centres wishing to opt for the RDAA Insurance instead of the AON may do so however this cost will not be met by RDAQ.
- Payment for RDAA insurance must be met by centres and paid to RDAA through RDAQ as per RDAA requirements
- Please note it is important to select either RDAQ or RDAA Insurance Policy; i.e. we cannot offer Aon Insurance to centres opting to take the RDAA package as we consider this to be an unnecessary duplication and expense.
- RDAQ will also wave 2016 state administration cost for all centres.
- All Centres will be required to pay the 2016 RDAA fee of \$44.00 per rider as per the normal process;
- Board Notes that <u>all registrations and all other payments to RDAA must be</u> through RDAQ.
